This morning I have accepted the resignation of Mr. Tom Meutsch of East Carolina University as the Association's Vice President of Legislative Affairs, to take effect immediately. Mr. Meutsch's personal circumstances present a challenge to his continued effectiveness as Vice President, and in speaking with him at length we concluded his resignation would be in the mutual interests of himself and the Association.

In light of the vacancy resulting from Mr. Meutsch's resignation, I have consulted with Senior Vice President Yopp regarding a replacement. Based on those deliberations I have appointed Mr. Chazz Clevinger of UNC Chapel Hill to the position, transferring him from his current position as the Director of Strategic Initiatives. Mr. Clevinger's appointment is tentative pending completion of the standard background check.

As a stipend-receiving position, Mr. Clevinger's appointment also requires confirmation by the General Assembly of the Association at our next meeting at Appalachian State University on October 25th.

Given the time-sensitive projects currently in progress within the Committee on Legislative & Public Affairs, I will be meeting personally with Mr. Clevinger, Associate Vice President Andrew Tucker, Committee Chairman Rachel Hicks and Vice Chairman Kevin Kimball jointly at the meeting next week to assess status, project deadlines, and next steps. I have also encouraged Mr. Clevinger to contact the respective Student Body Presidents to gauge their needs as it relates to the Division of Legislative & Public Affairs.

My expectation is for this transition to take place with minimal disruption to the Association's overall activities.
